Introduction

This Japanese Industrial Standard has been prepared based on the second edition of ISO 10474 published in 2013 with some modifications of the technical contents.

The portions given dotted underlines are the matters in which the contents of the corresponding International Standard have been modified. A list of modifications with the explanations is given in Annex JA.

1 Scope

This Standard defines the different types of inspection documents supplied to the purchaser, in accordance with the requirements of the order, for the delivery of steel and steel products specified in Japanese Industrial Standards. This Standard is also applicable to other products upon agreement between the purchaser and the manufacturer.

This Standard is to be used in conjunction with other Japanese Industrial Standards which specify the general technical delivery conditions :

- for steel and steel products, see **JIS G 0404**;
- for steel castings, see **JIS G 0307**.

NOTE : The International Standard corresponding to this Standard and the symbol of degree of correspondence are as follows.

ISO 10474 : 2013 *Steel and steel products — Inspection documents* (MOD)

In addition, symbols which denote the degree of correspondence in the contents between the relevant International Standard and **JIS** are IDT (identical), MOD (modified), and NEQ (not equivalent) according to ISO/IEC Guide 21-1.
