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Foreword

Introduction

This Japanese Industrial Standard has been prepared based on **ISO 9185**:2007, Edition 2, with some modifications of the technical contents in consideration of convenience in usage.

The vertical lines on both sides and dotted underlines indicate changes from the corresponding International Standard. A list of modifications with the explanations is given in Annex JA.

1 Scope

This Standard specifies a method for assessing the heat penetration resistance of materials intended for use in protective clothing to protect against splashes of molten metal. It covers the assessment of the effects of splashes of molten aluminium, molten cryolite, molten copper, molten iron and molten mild steel.
